STIPULATION AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL AS TO DEFENDANT STANSLAV KAMINSKY

Pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Commission") and Defendant Stanslav Kaminsky ("Kaminsky"), through their undersigned counsel, that:

- 1. The Commission and Kaminsky have settled all claims asserted by the Commission against Kaminsky in the above-captioned case in the administrative action, In the Matter of Stanslav Kaminsky, Administrative Proceeding No. 3-11023, instituted on January 29, 2003. All claims against Kaminsky in the above-captioned matter are hereby dismissed with prejudice pursuant to the parties' settlement.
- 2. Kaminsky understands and agrees to comply with the Commission's policy "not to permit a defendant or respondent to consent to a judgment or order that imposes a sanction while denying the allegations in the complaint or order for

proceedings" (17 C.F.R. §202.5(e)). In compliance with this policy, Kaminsky agrees: (i) not to take any action or to make or permit to be made any public statement denying, directly or indirectly, any allegation in the Complaint or creating the impression that the Complaint is without factual basis; and (ii) that upon the filing of this Stipulation, Kaminsky hereby withdraws any papers filed in this action to the extent that they deny any allegation in the Complaint. If Kaminsky breaches this agreement, the Commission may petition the Court to vacate the Order and restore this case to its active docket.

Nothing in this provision affects Kaminsky's: (i) testimonial obligations; or (ii) right to take legal or factual positions in litigation in which the Commission is not a party; and

3. Kaminsky hereby waives any rights under the Equal Access to Justice Act, the Small Business Regulatory Enforcement Fairness Act of 1996 or any other provision of law to pursue reimbursement of attorneys' fees or other fees, expenses or costs expended by Defendant Kaminsky to defend against this action. For these purposes, Kaminsky agrees that he is not the prevailing party in this action since the parties have reached a good faith settlement.
